**ENTRY DEADLINE: August 1, each year**

### Canadian Pinto Youth Challenge

Must be a Youth or Family member of the Canadian Pinto Horse Association. Open to all Canadian Pinto Horse Association Youth 8 to 17 years of age. The horse or pony must be registered by the Canadian Pinto Horse Association. A Copy of registration papers will be required. The Canadian Pinto horse or pony must be registered and can be owned or leased by the Youth member. Only mares and geldings will be allowed. Breeding stock Canadian Pinto's are eligible. A **helmet MUST be worn by ALL Youth participating**. For **SAFETY** sake, Youth 12 and under will need a parent present throughout the course.

This is a non-competitive format. Parents can give verbal suggestions to complete the course. One hour prior to starting all participants can work on the obstacles. It is the hope that this Challenge will help give a base in creating well rounded Canadian Pintos which can be used anywhere. The cost will be \$15.00 per youth/horse or pony. The course will be on a point system. If the Youth/Horse(Pony) complete the task asked, they get the points.

The course will be as follows

**Level 1:** Level 1 will receive a Halter if they earn 70 points or more!  
Pick up all 4 horse hoofs (5pts each).....20 points  
Halter Broke:  
♦ walk approximately 10 steps.....10 points  
♦ trot approximately 10 steps .....10 points  
♦ halt and stand for 5 seconds .....10 points  
♦ back 3 steps ..... 10 points  
Load in trailer .....40 points

**Level 2:**Level 2 will receive Grooming kit if they earn 70 points or more!  
Level 2 can only be entered if level 1 was completed the previous year.  
Tie horse properly(horse to stand for 2 minutes).....20 points  
Put on splint boots or leg wraps.....10 points  
The following 3 steps preformed on a lunge line:  
♦ walk two rounds.....20 points  
♦ halt.....20 points  
♦ trot two rounds (opposite direction).....20 points  
Name ten parts of the horse (2 points per part).....20 points

**Level 3:** Level 3 will receive TBA if they earn 70 points or more!  
Level 3 can only be entered if Level 2 was completed the previous year.  
Saddle your horse (English or Western).....40 points  
Properly bridle your horse.....20 points  
Mount your horse properly.....20 points  
Dismount your horse properly.....20 points

**Level 4:** Level 4 will receive TBA if they earn 70 points or more!  
Level 4 can only be entered if Level 3 was completed the previous year.  
Check Tack & Mount.....10 points  
Back.....10 points  
Walk in large circle (both ways), Reverse at starting point.....10 points  
Trot in a large circle (both ways) Reverse at starting point.....20 points  
Lope in a large circle (both ways) Using correct lead.....50 points

**Level 5:** Level 5 will receive TBA if they earn 70 points or more!  
Level 5 can only be entered if Level 4 was completed the previous year.  
Riding pattern with lead changes.....100 points  
(Pattern to be determined)

**Level 6:** Level 6 will receive TBA if they earn 70 points or more!  
Judge to advise rider what skills must be illustrated.....100 points

**NOTE:** Under special approved circumstances for all levels – A borrowed horse or pony may be used to achieve levels as long as the horse/pony being used is a Registered Canadian Pinto, including recognized Canadian Pinto Breeding Stock. (ONLY IN YOUTH CHALLENGE)
